

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

### **MANDATORY COURSE ON PROFESSIONALISM – CONDITION OF ADMISSION TO THE COLORADO BAR**

In accordance with Rule 201.14(3), C.R.C.P., **before taking the oath of admission as an attorney licensed to practice law in Colorado, you are required to attend the six-hour course “Practicing with Professionalism”** jointly sponsored by the Colorado Bar Association and the Office of Attorney Regulation Counsel. This one-day course is offered several times throughout the year and in accordance with the above-cited rule is valid for one calendar year.

The course may be completed either before or after sitting for the Colorado bar examination; however, you are encouraged to register and complete this course as soon as feasible, as classroom size is limited and the space fills quickly. Do not wait until the last minute to register for this course, as your admission to the bar will be delayed in the event you are unable to complete it prior to the swearing-in ceremony. *The date of the swearing-in ceremony is set by the Colorado Supreme Court, typically sometime shortly following the bar examination.
