

## **Multistate Professional Responsibility Exam (MPRE)**

All applicants must successfully complete the Multistate Professional Responsibility Exam (MPRE) with a minimum scaled score of 85.

Passing MPRE scores are valid if achieved at an examination taken no more than two years prior to filing an application for admission in Colorado. The MPRE need not have been completed prior to filing an application for admission in Colorado; however, final approval for admission to practice law in this state will be held in abeyance until valid MPRE scores have been received and verified by this Board. See Rule 201.5(3), C.R.C.P.

For time limits on taking the oath of admission, refer to Rule 201.14, C.R.C.P.
