People v. Agbakwu, No. 03PDJ047, 07.24.03. Attorney Regulation. The Presiding Disciplinary Judge approved the parties' Conditional Admission of Misconduct and suspended Respondent, Charles A. Agbakwu, Sr., attorney registration number 24447 from the practice of law for a period of ninety days, all but thirty days stayed followed by a two-year period of probation subject to conditions. Respondent was engaged as alternate defense counsel in a number of cases. The bills he submitted contained duplicative billing. Respondent did not accurately divide the time among the total number of clients when he visited his clients or attended hearings. Respondent's conduct violated Colo. RPC 8.4(c). Respondent was ordered to pay costs of the proceeding.
