People v. Essling, No. 99PDJ020, 7/16/99. Attorney Regulation.

The Presiding Disciplinary Judge accepted the parties' Conditional Admission of Misconduct and suspended respondent, Timothy J. Essling, from the practice of law for a period of one year and one day, with the full term of suspension stayed on the condition that respondent be placed on probation for a period of one year and one day subject to certain conditions.

Respondent neglected legal matters in violation of Colo. RPC 1.3; failed to communicate with a client in violation of Colo. RPC 1.4(a) and (b), and failed to protect client interests upon terminating representation in violation of Colo. RPC 1.16(d). Respondent was ordered to pay the costs of the disciplinary proceedings.
