*People v. Jones.* 12PDJ031. August 21, 2012. Attorney Regulation. The Presiding Disciplinary Judge suspended Robert D. Jones (Attorney Registration Number 25393) from the practice of law for a period of one year and one day, all but six months stayed upon the successful completion of a two-year period of probation, subject to conditions, effective August 21, 2012. Jones failed to communicate with three clients and ultimately abandoned their cases. In addition, a court held Jones in contempt for his failure to follow court orders in his divorce proceeding, and Jones failed to appear in court for sentencing on the contempt. Finally, Jones failed to respond to demands for information during the investigation of this matter. Jones's misconduct constitutes grounds for the imposition of discipline pursuant to C.R.C.P. 251.5 and violated Colo. RPC 1.3, 1.4(a)-(b), 1.16(d), 3.4(c), and 8.1(b).
