People v. Mathews. 13PDJ051. June 24, 2013. Attorney Regulation. The Presiding Disciplinary Judge approved a conditional admission of misconduct submitted by the parties and disbarred Walter Mathews IV (Attorney Registration Number 31109) from the practice of law, effective June 24, 2013. In 2012, Mathews, while employed as general counsel for a rural transportation authority, took between \$500.00 and \$20,000.00 from his employer. On May 28, 2013, Mathews pled guilty to felony and misdemeanor theft. Mathews has paid his employer \$32,000.00 in restitution. Mathews's misconduct constitutes grounds for the imposition of discipline pursuant to C.R.C.P. 251.5 and violated Colo. RPC 8.4(b) and 8.4(c).
