People v. Smith, No. 04PDJ033. 4/20/04. Attorney Regulation. The Presiding Disciplinary Judge approved the parties' Conditional Admission of Misconduct and suspended Respondent Keith C. Smith, attorney registration number 31962, from the practice of law in the State of Colorado, for a period of sixty days, all stayed upon successful completion of a two-year period of probation effective May 21, 2004. Respondent was involved in a physical altercation with his girlfriend for which he pled guilty to a misdemeanor crime of harassment and received a deferred sentence. The Respondent's misconduct violates Colo. RPC 8.4(b). Respondent was ordered to pay the costs incurred in this proceeding and comply with other conditions.
