IN RE: ADVISORY COMMITTEE'S RECOMMENDATION OF A PILOT
PROGRAM CONCERNING PARAPROFESSIONALS AND LEGAL
SERVICES

ORDER OF THE COURT

Upon consideration of the recommendation of the Supreme Court Advisory Committee and a subcommittee, then-named Providers of Alternative Legal Services, to adopt a pilot program allowing paralegals and other non-lawyers to provide certain types of legal services in defined contexts, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a new subcommittee be created effective Feb. 27, 2020, to explore the possible creation of a regulatory regime for licensing qualified paraprofessionals to engage in the practice of law in defined contexts, including authorized scopes of work in certain types of domestic relations matters, and shall function until this Order is vacated by the Court. The subcommittee shall be chaired by Hon. (Ret.) Angela Arkin and Maha Kamal, and Justice Melissa Hart shall serve as the liaison justice to this subcommittee. Ms. Arkin and Ms. Kamal shall propose to the Supreme Court Advisory Committee, for its approval, other individuals to serve on the subcommittee. The subcommittee shall submit its findings and final proposals to the Supreme Court Advisory Committee for its review and any recommendation to the Supreme Court.
