People v. Richardson, No. 02PDJ026, 6.11.02. Attorney Regulation. The Presiding Disciplinary Judge approved the parties' Conditional Admission of Misconduct and suspended Respondent, Russell W. Richardson, attorney registration number 06232, from the practice of law for a period of thirty days, all stayed during a one year period of probation subject to conditions. In one matter, respondent engaged in neglect by failing to file disclosures, failing to prepare a settlement statement, failing to bring a cross-claim on behalf of his client and failing to respond to a pending motion to annul a stay in bankruptcy in violation of Colo. RPC 1.3. Respondent violated Colo. RPC 1.7(b) by representing two parties with adverse interests. Respondent was ordered to pay the costs of the disciplinary proceeding.
